

Starting Operations from Narita Airport Terminal 1!

- The convenience of Narita, an important location for the Tokyo area, just got even better -

- Peach moved terminals at Narita Airport to Terminal 1.
- Boarding procedures for domestic flights are at the domestic flight area in the South Wing, and international flights are at the North Wing B Counter.
- We restart operation of international flights from Narita, Haneda and Kansai - Taipei (Taoyuan) from Oct. 25.
- Also, on the same day, Peach opens the Sapporo (New-Chitose) / Sendai - Okinawa (Naha) routes.

Osaka Oct. 25, 2020 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) moved its terminal at Narita Airport from Terminal 3 to Terminal 1 today, Oct. 25.



When flying Peach at Narita Airport, boarding procedures have moved to the domestic check-in counter on the first floor of the South Wing and the B counter on the fourth floor of the North Wing for international flights.

In anticipation of further expansion of the Tokyo area network after COVID-19, by using the terminal directly connected to the railway station, passengers who use the railway from the Tokyo area as well as those living near Narita Airport have better access, which further improves convenience.

We have also restarted some international flights today. We will operate three flights a week from Tokyo (Narita), Tokyo (Haneda) and Osaka (Kansai) to Taipei (Taoyuan). We will serve a role as a public transportation system for “people who need to move” for business or study abroad while we work to control infection and revitalize the economy.

In addition, Peach has started service on the Sapporo (New-Chitose) / Sendai - Okinawa (Naha) route today. Both routes are once a day round trips. The network of domestic flights to and from each airport has expanded further, with five routes each for Okinawa (Naha), Sapporo (New-Chitose), and three for Sendai.

From Dec. 24, we will start service at Chubu Airport, connecting the Nagoya (Chubu) - Sapporo (New-Chitose) route with two round trips a day and the Nagoya (Chubu) - Sendai route with one round trip a day.

Peach will continue to provide affordable travel at low fares as a bridge connecting regions while thoroughly implementing infection countermeasures under the theme of “Bridging your Sky” while continuing to expand its network.

Peach began operating out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. Peach currently services 26 domestic and 17 international routes with 32 aircraft from its hubs: New-Chitose Airport, Sendai Airport, Narita Airport, Fukuoka Airport and Naha Airport in addition to Kansai Airport. From Dec. 24, Peach will start operating new routes from Chubu Airport, Sapporo (New-Chitose)/Sendai - Nagoya (Chubu) and make Chubu Airport its new hub. From Oct.25, Peach will restart international flights connecting Osaka (Kansai)/Tokyo (Narita)/Tokyo (Haneda) - Taipei (Taoyuan). Aiming to become the leading LCC in Asia, we are expanding our route network from various regions, mainly in the Tokyo metropolitan area and Kansai. Also, we moved our boarding terminal at Narita Airport from Terminal 3 to Terminal 1. Boarding procedures are made at check-in counter on the first floor of the South Wing for domestic flights and the B counter on the fourth floor of the North Wing for international flights. When flying Peach for international flights at Kansai Airport, boarding procedures are made at the Terminal 2, and passengers are arrived at Terminal 1.
