Tickets for Okinawa (Naha) - Hong Kong service go on sale today!

~The only regular service on this route offered by a Japanese airline resumes on June 28~

- Okinawa (Naha) Hong Kong service 7 flights/week, starting at 6,980 yen one-way~
- Increased service on Okinawa (Naha) Taipei (Taoyuan) route also, further expanding the Naha Airport international network
- A total of 8 routes offered in and out of Naha Airport during the 2019 summer schedule

Osaka 14 February 2019 - Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach"; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) will launch ticket sales for resumed Okinawa (Naha) - Hong Kong flight service out of Naha Airport today. Service on the Okinawa (Naha) - Hong Kong route will resume on Friday, June 28, 2019, with seven flights a week and airfare starting at 6,980 yen. The route has been on hiatus since Sunday, October 29, 2017, but it will resume at this time as the only flight on this route offered by a Japanese airline.

In addition, Okinawa (Naha) - Taipei (Taoyuan) service, for which there are currently 14 flights per week, will increase to 21 flights per week on Friday, June 28 due to the popularity of the route. The sales for this route started on February 12.

Starting Monday, March 18, Peach's domestic and international check-in counters at Naha Airport will move from the airport's LCC Terminal to the third floor of the Passenger Terminal Building. This will allow direct access from the Okinawa Urban Monorail, buses, taxis and privet cars, making it more convenient.

We expect that expanding the international network at Naha Airport, a Peach hub, will make it easier for more inbound passengers to visit Okinawa, and thus Japan, via Naha Airport, known as the southern gateway to Japan.

Also Peach will resume Tokyo (Narita) – Okinawa (Naha) flight from June 1, 2019. The schedule and airfare will annouce on Peach web side later on. The number of Peach routes in and out of Naha Airport during the 2019 summer schedule will increase to three domestic and five international for a total of eight routes.

Going forward, Peach will continue to serve as a "bridge between Japan and Asia," actively expanding routes out of Naha Airport while contributing to the revitalization of Okinawa.
