

Seat Sales Start Today: Peach to Open Okinawa (Naha) – Kaohsiung Route as it Brings Japan and Asia Closer

Start date for services: April 26, 2018 (Thu)Fares: 4,980 yen to 35,880 yen

Osaka 24 January, 2018 - Starting on April 26 (Thu), Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach"; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) will be offering a daily flight to and from Okinawa (Naha) and Kaohsiung. Seat sales will begin at 4 p.m. today.

As a major city that represents Southern Taiwan, Kaohsiung offers not only gourmet food that is unique to Taiwan. It's a photogenic, artistic area with art museums and historical buildings. Peach hopes that the opening of its new route will make Kaohsiung closer for people in Okinawa and also enable residents in Kaohsiung to visit Okinawa at their leisure and further invigorate exchange between Japan and Taiwan through Okinawa.

The new route will be Peach's second route to Kaohsiung to follow the Osaka (Kansai) – Kaohsiung route that opened in January 2014. It will be the fourth international route to be operated to and from Okinawa to follow Taipei (Taoyuan), Seoul (Incheon), and Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi).

Set out on a casual trip made possible by Peach on its "flying train" and experience a tropical beach in Okinawa followed by afternoon tea at a fashionable café in Kaohsiung.

Peach will continue to aim to become "a bridge between Japan and Asia" and aggressively develop new routes while delivering happy, casual air travel.

Peach began services in March 2012 with Kansai Airport as its hub. It established secondary hubs at Naha Airport in July 2014 and Sendai Airport in September 2017. It currently flies 20 aircraft on 14 domestic and 14 international routes, operating a maximum of more than 100 flights daily and servicing more than 13,000 passengers. Peach is also planning to open a route between Osaka (Kansai) and Niigata on March 1, 2018 and Osaka (Kansai) and Kushiro on August 1 and is scheduled to set up a secondary hub at Shin-Chitose Airport during FY 2018.
