3)Overview

While the total number of seats offered on domestic and international routes combined were 101.0% against a year earlier, the number of passengers were 100.0%, showing steady performance overall.

During the period number of passenger was increased despite some flight was canceled due to thyhoon No. 9 and No.10. Particularly good performance was seen on all domestic routes, Taipei and Shanghai on international routes.

Peach began services based out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. Currently, in addition to Kansai Airport, Peach has hubs at New Chitose Airport, Sendai Airport, and Naha Airport with 27 aircraft that service 17 domestic routes and 17 international routes. It operates approximately 120 flights per day and is used by over 18,000 passengers daily. Peach will complete its integration with Narita-based airline Vanilla Air by the end of the 2019 fiscal year, aiming to become Asia's leading LCC.
