

After a long wait for the Tokyo Metropolitan Area, Service between Tokyo (Haneda) and Seoul (Incheon) will Resume!

-Take a day trip with daily flights! Convenient travel to Seoul will soon return! -

- **Daily service between Tokyo (Haneda) and Seoul (Incheon) will resume on October 30**
- **The route will resume operation for the first time in approximately two and a half years**
- **Tickets go on sale on August 23 at 4:00 p.m.**
- **Fares start at ¥5,680 with no fuel surcharge**
- **Flights between Osaka (Kansai) and Seoul (Incheon) will also increase from 6 to 14 round trips per week**

Osaka August 23, 2022 - Peach Aviation Limited (hereafter, Peach; Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) will resume flights on its Tokyo (Haneda) – Seoul (Incheon) route on October 30. Tickets will go on sale today at 4:00 p.m. (JST).

The Tokyo (Haneda) – Seoul (Incheon) route, which was suspended on March 2, 2020, will resume after approximately two and a half years and will operate daily. Fares start at ¥5,680 with no fuel surcharge. In addition, the Osaka (Kansai) – Seoul (Incheon) route, which will resume on August 28 with 6 round trips a week, will be increased to 14 flights a week starting on October 30. This route will also operate daily.



Peach, which was the first LCC in Japan to offer service to Haneda Airport, began service between Tokyo (Haneda) and Seoul (Incheon) in 2016. Peach has been proposing new, convenient travel styles for those in the Tokyo metropolitan area that are made possible by our low fares, such as the popularization of taking advantage of the late-night early-morning slots at Haneda to leave for Seoul after work for a day trip to enjoy local gourmet and shopping.

Peach's international routes have been used by roughly 13 million customers, about 5 million of whom traveled between Japan and South Korea.

Peach CEO Takeaki Mori has the following to say about the resumption of service out of Haneda. "People of the Tokyo metropolitan area, we apologize for keeping you waiting! At long last, Peach will return to Haneda! The Haneda-Incheon route is a popular route that has been well-received by many lovers of South Korea who appreciate being able to fly there on a day trip alone after work or take a weekend trip there with friends. When the Kansai-Incheon route resumes operations on August 28, I hope that you will use Peach's enhanced domestic network to travel to South Korea

via Tokyo or Osaka from various places in Japan, and to travel to various places in Japan from South Korea. Peach will continue to resume international routes and expand its international network. We aim to achieve convenient air travel that once again makes Japan and Asia more easily accessible from Haneda, Narita, and Kansai.”

All of Peach’s international routes have been suspended since April 8, 2021, but we will gradually resume service starting on August 28.
