And next, finally Taiwan! Osaka (Kansai) - Taipei (Taoyuan) Route Resumes Service After Almost One and a Half Years!

- As a bridge to Asia, we will once again connect Japan and Taiwan from the gateway of Osaka -
 - The Osaka (Kansai) Taipei (Taoyuan) route will resume service on September 16 with two round trips per week
 - The route has resumed operations for the first time in approximately one and a half years
 - Tickets go on sale July 14 at 2:00 p.m. (JST)

Osaka, July 14, 2022 Peach Aviation Limited (hereafter, Peach; Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) will resume flights on its Osaka (Kansai) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route on September 16. Tickets will go on sale today at 2:00 p.m. (JST)

The Osaka - Taipei route will resume service after almost one and a half years since its suspension on April 8, 2021, with two round trip flights per week for the time being.



Peach has served approximately 13 million passengers on Peach's international flights to date by proposing new travel styles, such as one-day trips overseas, and by making overseas travel more accessible. Of these, more than 5 million passengers have traveled on routes between Japan and Taiwan.

Regarding the resumption of Peach's second international route following the Osaka (Kansai) - Seoul (Incheon) route announced last month, Representative Director and CEO Mori has commented, "Our next international route is to Taiwan! Peach was launched Osaka (Kansai) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route in October 2012, and Peach has operated 10 routes between Japan and Taiwan which was the largest number of Peach's international routes. It has made the movement of people, goods, and services between Japan and Taiwan more convenient. We hope that visitors will travel to Taiwan from other parts of Japan as well via Kansai Airport, and from Taiwan to other parts of Japan. Peach will continue to expand its international flight network in order to resume international flights with the aim of once again becoming a bridge to Asia, and to attract many visitors from overseas to the Osaka Expo in 2025. We also hope that people will be able to interact with each other even more actively".

Peach will once again serve as a "bridge to Asia", offering easy air travel and contributing to the revitalization of population exchange between Japan and the rest of Asia. We are waiting for you with thorough infection control measures, and with safety as the top priority. Feel safe, and enjoy your trip or return home with Peach this summer.

Peach had suspended all international flights since April 8, 2021. However, the Osaka (Kansai) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route will be the second international route to resume service, following the Osaka (Kansai) - Seoul (Incheon) route, which will resume service on August 28 of this year.
