

## Fly overseas from as low as ¥5,000 one-way! 2023 Summer Schedule Tickets for International Routes on Sale Now!

**Osaka, December 22, 2022** - Peach Aviation Limited (hereinafter: Peach, Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) will start sales of air tickets for international routes for the 2023 summer schedule. The applicable period is from March 26 to October 28, 2023.

The routes and fares for the 2023 summer schedule period, which will be on sale starting today, are shown in the table below. Tickets for other routes will go on sale as soon as they are ready. Tickets can be purchased via the Peach Website ([www.flypeach.com](http://www.flypeach.com)) and at the Contact Center.

Peach has accelerated the resumption of international flights since August 2022, beginning with the Osaka (Kansai) / Tokyo (Haneda) - Seoul (Incheon) routes and the Osaka (Kansai) / Tokyo (Narita, Haneda) / Okinawa (Naha) - Taipei (Taoyuan) routes. The Osaka (Kansai) - Hong Kong route will also resume on January 20, bringing Peach's international routes back up to eight. In addition, the Osaka (Kansai) - Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi) route, the first medium-haul route to be served six times a week starting December 27, will be operated daily from the 2023 summer schedule.

Peach will continue to place the highest priority on safe operations and thorough infection control measures, and will work with customers to create new travel styles while providing easy travel at stable, low fares. And as a "bridge between Asia," we will incorporate the flow of people, goods, and things, and will once again revitalize Japan toward Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan.
