<Domestic Routes>

Peak travel day: April 27 for outbound and inbound.

Reservations for flights bound for Kyushu and Okinawa area have been particularly strong, with some flights already almost fully booked.

<International Routes>

Peak travel day: Apr. 27 for outbound, May 5 for inbound.

Reservations for flights bound for Hong Kong and Shanghai have been particularly strong.

Peach Aviation began services based out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. Currently, in addition to Kansai Airport, Peach has hubs at New Chitose Airport, Sendai Airport, and Naha Airport with 25 airplanes that service 16 domestic routes and 15 international routes. It operates approximately 100 flights per day and is used by over 13,000 passengers daily. Peach will complete its integration with Narita-based airline Vanilla Air by the end of the 2019 fiscal year, aiming to become Asia's leading LCC.
