Peach Announces Traffic result for The FY2019 Year End and New Year Period

3) Topics

Total number of supplied seats was 133.8% and the total number of passengers was 132.9% compared to the previous year.

As for domestic flights, Sapporo, Kushiro and Sendai routes were especially strong, and the peak was on December 30 for outbound and on January 5 for inbound. As for international flights, Taipei, Kaoshun, Shanghai routes were especially strong, and the peak was on December 29 for outbound and on January 5 for inbound.

Peach began operating out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. It currently services 21 domestic and 19 international routes with 30 aircraft from its bases: New Chitose Airport, Sendai Airport, Narita Airport, Fukuoka Airport and Naha Airport in addition to Kansai Airport. It operates approximately 140 flights per day, and over 20,000 passengers fly the airline every day. Peach integrated with Vanilla Air, based in Narita Airport, on November 1, 2019 and aim to become Asia's leading LCC.
