3) Overview

<Domestic Routes>

Peak travel day: April 30 for outbound, May 4 for inbound.

For domestic flight all route had high demand during the period.

<International Routes>

Peak travel day: Apr. 29 for outbound, May 5 for inbound.

For international flights bound for Shanghai(Pudong) and Hong Kong had particularly strong. Peach new international route Sapporo(New Chitose) - Seoule(Incheon) which started on April 25 had also high demand during the period.

Peach Aviation began services based out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. Currently, in addition to Kansai Airport, Peach has hubs at New Chitose Airport, Sendai Airport, and Naha Airport that service 16 domestic routes and 16 international routes. It operates approximately 100 flights per day and is used by over 13,000 passengers daily. Peach will complete its integration with Narita-based airline Vanilla Air by the end of the 2019 fiscal year, aiming to become Asia's leading LCC.
