

Peach Offering “Narita to Nagasaki and Kagoshima” Service! ~Peach Expands Flight Network to Kyushu!~

- Tokyo (Narita) – Nagasaki: One roundtrip flight daily starting on Sunday, March 29, from ¥5,890 one way
- Tokyo (Narita) – Kagoshima: Two roundtrip flights daily starting on Sunday, March 29, from ¥5,890 one way
- Osaka (Kansai) – Miyazaki to two roundtrips daily and Osaka (Kansai) - Kagoshima to three roundtrips daily
- Tickets on sale starting at 17:00 today except for some flights

Osaka 28 January, 2020 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) today announced the carrier will add new service between Tokyo (Narita) and Nagasaki and between Tokyo (Narita) and Kagoshima . Tickets will go on sale at 17:00 today. Both routes will start on Sunday, March 29, the first day of the summer flight schedule for 2020.



With today’s addition of two new domestic routes, Peach will serve eight domestic and two international routes for a total of ten Narita routes. Peach now flies to four destinations in Kyushu: Fukuoka, Nagasaki, Kagoshima, and Amami. The Company provides “flying trains” to encourage more travel between Kyushu and the metropolitan areas.

In addition, the number of Osaka (Kansai) – Miyazaki flights will increase from one to two roundtrips daily starting on Sunday, March 29. On the same day, the number of Osaka (Kansai) – Kagoshima flights will increase from two to three roundtrips daily. With these additional flights, Peach will expand its flight network between the Tokyo/Kansai regions and Kyushu to nine domestic routes, four out of Narita Airport and five out of Kansai Airport. Peach would like to encourage more people to take weekend or day trips to Kyushu with Peach’s easy and affordable flights.

Peach has been using Fukuoka Airport as one of its bases since November of last year. This allowed the company to start flying an international route out of Kyushu for the first time (Fukuoka – Taipei). Peach will continue to add new routes and contribute to the further development and revitalization of the overall economy in Kyushu.

Peach is committed to expanding its network of “flying trains” and taking on the challenge of becoming Asia’s leading low-cost carrier. Please stay tuned for more from Peach.
