Okinawa (Naha) - Taipei (Taoyuan) Route Resumes after 2
years and 8 months
Flights between Tokyo (Narita) and Taipei (Taoyuan) Route
will be Daily!
-Further boost tourism and inbound demand, which is Peach's

- Okinawa (Naha) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route resumes operation from November 17
- The route will resume operation for the first time in approximately two years and eight months
- Tokyo (Narita) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route will operate daily from October 30.

October 13, 2022, Osaka Peach Aviation Co., Ltd. (hereinafter: Peach, Representative Director & CEO: Takeaki Mori) will resume flights on Okinawa (Naha) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route from November 17, and start operating daily on Tokyo (Narita) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route from October 30. Each ticket will go on sale today at 4:00 p.m.

The Okinawa (Naha) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route will resume operations for the first time in approximately 2 years and 8 months since it was suspended on March 20, 2020, and for the time being, it will operate seven round trips a week daily.

The Okinawa (Naha) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route announced this time will be Peach's fifth international route to resume.



Peach had suspended all international flights since April 8, 2021, but resumed the Osaka (Kansai) - Seoul (Incheon) route on August 28, the Osaka (Kansai) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route on September 16, and the Tokyo (Narita) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route on September 22. The Tokyo (Haneda) - Seoul (Incheon) route resumed on October 30, and the Osaka (Kansai) - Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi) route will start on December 27.

Representative Director & CEO Takeaki Mori commented: "Thank you for waiting everyone in

Okinawa and Taiwan. Finally, international flights from Okinawa will resume. The Okinawa (Naha) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route was launched in September 2013, and Okinawa, which is close to Asia, such as being able to go to Taiwan in an hour and a half, is one of the base airports representing Peach, which aims to be a bridge between Asia. Travel restrictions between Japan and Taiwan have been greatly eased, and from now on, people will start coming and going again. Peach will further boost tourism and inbound demand, which is one of Peach's strengths, by realizing easy travel from Naha, Kansai, and Narita to Taiwan, and from Taiwan to various parts of Japan. Peach will continue to expand its international flight network in order to resume international flights with the aim of once again becoming a bridge to Asia, and to attract many visitors from overseas to the Osaka Expo in 2025. We also hope that people will be able to interact with each other even more actively."

Peach will once again serve as a "bridge to Asia," offering easy air travel and contributing to the revitalization of population exchange between Japan and the rest of Asia. We are waiting for you with safe flight as the top priority, and with thorough infection control measures.
