## Infection Control Measures -Ensuring Onboard Health and Safety-

**Osaka, June 2, 2020** - Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach," Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) opened a special page dedicated to infection control measures.

Amongst the domestic routes which were suspended on 13 out of 22 routes, the Okinawa (Naha) – Fukuoka route has been back from June 1 and all of the remining routes will be back from June 19. We will continue to implement thorough infection control measures to ensure our customers' health and safety. In addition to the actions taken by our staffs, we are also asking for passengers' cooperation, such as wearing masks and ensuring social distance, and we will seek to propose the new way of flying as per "The new lifestyle".

## <Infection Control Measures at the airport>

- Requiring ground attendant to wear mask at all airports and to wear extra face covering at some airports to prevent droplet infection
- Setting up prevention sheet for droplet infection at counter

## <Infection Control Measures in the cabin>

- Requiring all cabin crew to wear masks and gloves
- Disinfecting aircraft including tables, armrests, seat equipment, toilet doorknobs, and other parts with which passenger's hands come into contact
- Temporarily suspending all inflight shopping and food/drink service on board from March to maintain physical distance with passengers
- Completely replacing cabin air approximately every two to three minutes
- Filtering cabin air through high-performance HEPA filters to maintain air cleanliness in the cabin

## <Request for our passengers>

- Wearing masks at the airport and while traveling
- Taking temperature at home before traveling
- Keep social distancing at boarding area etc.
- Refraining from talking in the cabin to prevent droplet infection
- Washing hands before and after using the toilet
