New Collaboration Links Soaring Sky! Precure and Peach A New Wrapping Jet in the Skies! Collaboration Merchandise, Campaigns and More

The 20th installment in the Precure anime franchise "Soaring Sky! Precure" launched on Sunday, February 5. It is broadcast every Sunday morning at 8:30. Meanwhile, the franchise and Peach Aviation have announced they will collaborate.

A Peach jet featuring Soaring Sky! Precure wrapping is

decorating the skies with its motif of our world's endless Sky. This celebrates Peach's 11th anniversary of its operation on March 1, and marks its aim to serve as a bridge linking Japan to other parts of Asia. Surprising and exciting projects are being launched in association with this development. A press conference explaining the collaboration was held on Saturday, March 4.

At the press conference, the following comments on the collaboration were made by Akira Sekine, who is the voice behind CURE SKY/Sora Harewataru, and by Toei Animation Executive Producer Takashi Washio, Peach's creative director, cabin crew members, and "CURE SKY."

Peach started operating as Japan's first low-cost carrier on March 1, 2012. With seven base airports at New-Chitose, Sendai, Narita, Chubu, Kansai, Fukuoka, and Naha, Peach currently operates 31 domestic routes and 18 international routes using 33 aircraft. Peach's first medium-haul route, the Osaka (Kansai) - Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi) route, started service on December 27, 2022. On March 27, 2023, the Nagoya (Chubu) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route will start service. Going forward, Peach's goal is to support the comings and goings of people as a convenient means of air travel, contribute to the revitalization of local communities, and become the leading low-cost carrier in Asia.
