

In-Flight PEACH DELI Theme This Summer: Eastern Hokkaido

Local gourmet dishes to be offered ahead of the August opening of Peach's Kushiro route

- · In-flight PEACH DELI menu to be revamped to summer menu on June 1, 2018
- To introduce "Escalopes", a specialty of Nemuro and other gourmet dishes from Eastern Hokkaido
- Lineup to also include danishes and beverages flavored with "Haskap", a specialty fruit produced in Hokkaido

Osaka 31 May, 2018 - Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach"; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) will revamp its in-flight PEACH DELI offerings to a 2018 summer menu on June 1, 2018 (Fri).

To commemorate the opening of its Osaka (Kansai) – Kushiro route on August 1, the PEACH DELI summer 2018 menu will offer local specialty dishes from Eastern Hokkaido, where Kushiro is situated. The menu items will be available June 1 (Fri) through August 31 (Fri).

The highlight of the summer menu will be Escalopes, a specialty of Nemuro. The dish is a substantial entrée of buttered rice with bamboo shoots topped with cutlet covered in a rich Demi-Glace sauce which the locals refer to as "Esca" and is a popular menu item at coffee shops in Nemuro.

A Hokkaido-style Bento will also be on offer, which will include a balanced combination of local favorites including the popular karaage (fried chicken) dish Zangi originally created in Kushiro and Sardine Hokkaburi Sushi, a specialty sold at Kushiro Station.

The summer menu will also offer an introduction to light meals and beverages that use Haskap, a fruit grown exclusively in Hokkaido. Enjoy specially-made danishes filled with sweet-and-sour haskap jam and tea beverages with a clear, refreshing taste with the haskap aroma, available only in Hokkaido and during this period only.

Look forward to more from Peach as it plans to offer more tasty, interesting, and innovative in-flight meals offered only on Peach.

About Peach (www.flypeach.com)

Peach began services based out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. It opened secondary hubs at Naha Airport in July 2014 and Sendai Airport in September 2017. It currently operates 20 aircraft on 15 domestic and 15 international routes, flying a maximum of more than 100 flights daily and serving more than 13,000 passengers. It is also scheduled to open an Osaka (Kansai) – Niigata route on March 1, 2018 and an Osaka (Kansai) – Kushiro route on August 1 as well as set up a hub at Shin-Chitose Airport during fiscal 2018.
