

## **Nagoya - Taipei Service Starts! Osaka - Kaohsiung Service Resumes! ~Celebrate Peach's First International Flight at Nagoya (Chubu) Airport~**

- **Starting March 27, seven weekly flights on the Nagoya (Chubu) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route**
- **Peach's First International Flight at Nagoya (Chubu) Airport**
- **Resumption of Osaka (Kansai) - Kaohsiung route Service After Nearly Three and a Half Years Expands the Number of International Routes to Five at Kansai!**

**Osaka, February 1, 2023** - Today, Peach Aviation Limited (hereinafter referred to as Peach, CEO: Takeaki Mori) announced that starting March 27 it will start operating the Nagoya (Chubu) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route, Peach's first international route at Nagoya (Chubu) Airport. Also, starting August 1, the Osaka (Kansai) - Kaohsiung route, which had been suspended for about three and a half years, will resume service. Tickets for both routes will go on sale today at 3:00 p.m. <sup>\*1</sup>

Peach launched first service at Nagoya (Chubu) Airport in December 2020 and began operating four domestic routes: Sapporo (New-Chitose), Sendai, Okinawa (Naha), and Ishigaki. The newly announced Taipei route is Peach's first international route from Nagoya (Chubu) Airport and will be operated seven times a week.

In addition, starting August 1, the Osaka (Kansai) - Kaohsiung route, which had been suspended since March 1, 2020, will resume service for the first time in three and a half years, with seven flights per week. There will be five international routes at Kansai Airport, including this route, bringing the total number of routes between Japan and Taiwan to six. The Osaka (Kansai) - Kaohsiung route will operate using the Airbus A321LR, which is equipped with a wider seat pitch and a USB port for charging as compared to the conventional Airbus A320ceo, allowing for a more relaxed and comfortable travel experience. <sup>\*2</sup>



On the occasion of the launch and resumption of flights, Representative Director and CEO Takeaki Mori commented, "Peach, the bridge between Asia and Japan, will finally operate international flights from Nagoya (Chubu) Airport. We are very happy to finally make this happen, as we have received requests from many people to operate international flights since we started

service at Nagoya (Chubu) Airport in 2020. Japanese visitors can depart from Nagoya after work or school on Friday, enjoy Taiwan's breakfast and night markets, and return to Nagoya the next morning. On the other hand, for inbound travelers, we recommend arriving early in the morning by Peach, enjoying the theme parks around Nagoya from the time they open, and then extending the trip to popular tourist destinations such as Shirakawa-go in Gifu, Hida Takayama, and Matsumoto in Nagano, for a relaxing tour. With the addition of the Osaka (Kansai) - Kaohsiung route, Peach will operate a total of six Taiwan routes, the most among Japanese carriers. Peach is committed to contributing to the revitalization of the Japanese economy while promoting interaction between people to liven up the Asian region."

Also, starting February 3, a "GO! Taiwan SALE" will be held to commemorate the launch and resumption of service. Value Peach fares (no flight change fee\*3) for the Nagoya (Chubu) - Taipei (Taoyuan) and Osaka (Kansai) - Kaohsiung routes are on sale at 30% off, starting at 13,280 yen, and other Taiwan routes are at 20% off, starting at 10,940 yen. We hope you will take advantage of this sale and enjoy Peach's unique and easy travel to Taiwan.

Peach will continue to provide easy travel with stable low fares, placing the highest priority on safe operations. We will also utilize our network, the largest of any LCC in Japan, to become a "bridge between Asia" for our customers, bringing the skies of Japan and Asia closer.
