Peach Announces Status of Seat Reservations for 2019 Bon Vacation Period

Osaka 2 August, 2019 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) today announced its reservations status for the Obon period (August 9-18) FY 2019.

3) Overview

The number of reservations are steady for the Bon vacation period on both domestic and international routes. The overall number of seats offered stands at 109.8% compared to a year earlier with the number of reservations at 105.5% YOY.

Reservations are steady on flights to and from Hokkaido and many bookings have already been received with a focus on routes bound for Taipei and Shanghai.

Peak days for domestic routes are August 10 on outbound and August 9 for inbound routes. Peak days for international routes are August 10 and 11 for outbound and August 12 and 18 for inbound routes.

Seats are still available on some days. Reservations may be made on the Peach website at www.flypeach.com. Seat availability may also be checked on the Peach website where information is updated daily.

Peach began services based out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. Currently, in addition to Kansai Airport, Peach has hubs at New Chitose Airport, Sendai Airport, and Naha Airport with 27 aircraft that service 17 domestic routes and 17 international routes. It operates approximately 120 flights per day and is used by over 18,000 passengers daily. Peach will complete its integration with Narita-based airline Vanilla Air by the end of the 2019 fiscal year, aiming to become Asia's leading LCC.
