Suspension of Flights due to the Spread of Novel Coronavirus

Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach," Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) notified Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport today that it will change some of its operation due to the spread of novel coronavirus. The changes are detailed below.
