

## **All international flights from Kansai and Haneda are back in operation!**

### **Shanghai route to resume service!**

**~The new system will expand travel options between Japan and Asia, making it even more convenient~**

- **Osaka (Kansai) - Shanghai (Pudong) route to resume on May 11, 2023, and Tokyo (Haneda) - Shanghai (Pudong) route on May 12, 2023**
- **Tickets on sale from March 31, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.**
- **Shanghai (Pudong) route from Kansai and Haneda to resume after 3 years**
- **Attracting inbound travel flow and boosting all areas of Japan**

Peach Aviation Limited (hereinafter: Peach, Representative Director & CEO: Takeaki Mori) will resume service on the Osaka (Kansai) - Shanghai (Pudong) route from May 11, 2023, and on the Tokyo (Haneda) - Shanghai (Pudong) route from May 12, with seven round trips per week. The Shanghai route has not been resumed in nearly three years, and tickets will go on sale today at 4:00 pm.

Flights from Osaka (Kansai) and Tokyo (Haneda) to Shanghai depart in the evening, making it an easy schedule after work or school. In addition, flights from Shanghai arrive in Japan in the morning, allowing passengers to enjoy Osaka and Tokyo to the fullest. Peach's domestic network allows passengers to fly from Kansai to Hokkaido and the Tohoku and Hokuriku regions, which offer magnificent nature that cannot be experienced in urban areas, and from Haneda to Kyushu and Okinawa by flying to Narita after enjoying the city center. We hope you will use Peach to truly experience Japan through all five senses.



With the resumption of the Shanghai route, all three international routes from Tokyo (Haneda), including Taipei (Taoyuan) and Seoul (Incheon), will be resumed. In addition, a total of six routes will be operated from Osaka (Kansai) to Seoul (Incheon), Taipei (Taoyuan), Hong Kong, and Kaohsiung, including the Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi) route launched in December 2022, bringing back full-scale international flight networks from Osaka and Tokyo. The boarding rate for international flights from February to March of this year was close to 90%, indicating that momentum for overseas travel is growing and that many inbound passengers have already boarded our flights.

Peach will continue to provide easy travel with stable low fares, placing the highest priority on safe operations. We will also utilize our network, the largest of any LCC in Japan, to become a "bridge between Asia" for our customers, bringing the skies of Japan and the rest of Asia closer.
