Peach Announces Traffic result for The FY2017 Year End and New Year Period

Osaka 4 January, 2018 - Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach"; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) today announced its traffic results for the FY 2017 year end through 2018 New Year period (December 28,2017 – January 3,2018).

3) Topics

Total supplied seats (102.5%) and total number of passenger (99.5%) was almost same level with previous year for all routes.

Performance was favorable on Kyushu direction for domestic and Shanghai, Taipei and Seoul for international flight. The peak days was 28th of December for domestic outbound and 3rd of January for inbound flight. For international flight ,outbound was 1st of January, inbound was 30th of December.

About Peach (www.flypeach.com)

Peach began its services in March 2012 with Kansai Airport as its hub. It established Naha Airport in July 2014 and Sendai Airport in September 2017 as secondary hubs. It currently flies 20 aircraft on 14 domestic and 14 international routes, operating a maximum of more than 100 flights daily and servicing more than 13,000 passengers. Peach is planning to open a route between Osaka (Kansai) and Niigata on March 1st and Osaka (Kansai) and Kushiro on August 1st 2018 and will also be setting up Shin-Chitose Airport as a hub during FY 2018.
